INTRODUCTION 1.0

The Shell Petroleum Development Company of Nigeria Limited (SPDC) in its role as Operator of the NNPC/SHELL/TotalEnergies/AGIP Joint Venture hereby announces to Provision of Land Transport Lifting and Hoisting Equipment Inspection and Competency Certification Services.

SPDC hereby invites reputable and competent Nigerian Companies and alliances with requisite experience and accreditation to apply to be considered for inclusion in the bidders list for subject tender.

The proposed contract will provisionally commence in Q3 2025 and remain active for 5 years' duration, followed by 2-year extension option.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK/SERVICE REQUIREMENT

Provision of Lifting Equipment Inspection & Certification

- Mobilization of resources and equipment to designated SHELL locations or approved contractor workshops in line with applicable shell land transport
- NDE/NDT, MPI, visual inspection, load testing, colour-coding, plating, certification on Lifted Equipment and Lifting Accessories in line with current SHELL standards, Nigerian statutory requirements and Industry standards periodically – every six (6) monthly and yearly intervals as may be prescribed by applicable industry standards or as recommended by a competent person.
- Provision of dead weights and water bags for use during testing and certification of lifting equipment, gears, and accessories.
- Re-spooling, treatment, and certification of wire ropes.
- Provision of safety split pins for Lifted equipment, lifting gears, and
- Tagging and Colour coding of all 'fit for purpose' lifting accessories and lifting points of lifted equipment with the prevailing colour code for the period. The tag shall carry all the required information including the inspection date, Safe Working Load/Workload Limits, Unique Identification Number, and the next inspection date.
- Generating and sending reports to Shell and the Director of Factories on
- NDT, MPI, Eddy current Inspection, visual inspection, proof load testing, plating, and certification of lifting appliances in line with current SHELL standards, Nigerian statutory requirements, and industry standards - every six (6) & twelve (12) monthly intervals, as applicable to the Lifting Equipment
- At the end of each job, an inspection report/certificate shall be generated and made available to the SHELL, and a copy sent to the director of factories.
- A register of lifting equipment shall be maintained/updated and made available as may be required in e-copy and hard copies for each facility.
- Inspection report repair/rejection generated shall also be made available to
- For all Equipment, Inspection reports shall be generated and issued within 24 hours of every inspection completed and certificates issued within 72 hours of Inspection.
- Draft copies signed by the competent inspector to be issued on-site to support urgent use of equipment.

Provision of Lifting and Hoisting Competency Certification

- Provision of comprehensive competence training (classroom and practical) for all categories of Lifting and Hoisting personnel which shall include but not be limited to Crane operators, forklift operators, Hiab operators, Pipe handler operators, MEWP operators, riggers/Banks man/Slinger, & Lifting and Hoisting supervisors, etc.
- Development of training curriculum in line with international standards ISO 15513 (CITB, NPORS, IADC, LEEA, or OPITO and other Industry equivalent shall be acceptable) to deliver on the above.
- Carry out competence assessments (written, oral, and hands-on) for all trainees and certify them when adjudged to be competent.
- Issue all competent trainees with special permits for their area of competence.
- Provision of comprehensive competence training (classroom and practical) of all nominated persons to a level adequate for certification as a lifting and Hoisting Appointed person' in line with the provisions of BS 7121.

- Development of training curriculum in line with international industry standards for this category of personnel concerning BS 7121 and LEEA or equivalent as will be agreed by L&H SME.
- Carry out competence assessment (written, oral, and hands-on) for all trainees and certify them as 'Lifting and Hoisting Appointed persons' when adjudged competent.
- Issue all competent trainees with valid certificates for their role as lifting and hoisting appointed persons.
- Provision of training manual and other supporting reference materials based.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS 3.0

- To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested contractors are required to be pre-qualified as essential service vendors in the 3.07.01 - Non-Destructive Testing (NDT)/NDE Services, 3.07.06 – Load Testing Services and 3.13.08 – Certification of Cranes and Lifting Appliances categories in NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS) data base in addition to possession of NUPRC permit on Specialized Oil and Gas Training Services – Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Training.
- Only successfully pre-qualified suppliers in these categories will receive
- Invitation to Technical Tender (ITT).

- To initiate the NJQS prequalification process, access www.nipex-ng.com to download the application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action.
- To be eligible, all tenders must comply with the Nigerian Content Requirements in the NipeX system.

4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

- To be eligible to participate in this tender, Tenderers must provide evidence I. of registration on the NCDMB NOGIC JQS.
- II. Demonstrate that entity is a Nigerian registered company with greater than 51% Nigerian shareholding. Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc.) including company memorandum & article of association and/or evidence of entity's incorporation, shareholding & ownership structure in Nigeria.
- III. Tenderer shall provide evidence of Category 1,2,3,4 or 5 Consultancy and related services NCEC demonstrating capacity to deploy competent resources in executing the work scope.
- IV. Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
- Tenderer shall provide documented evidence (not limited to workshop) ownership/rental of administrative office, maintenance demonstrating presence in Nigeria for the execution of the work scope.
