### **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

RENAISSANCE AFRICA ENERGY COMPANY LIMITED is committed to environmental management through emergency response to spills, recovery of the spilled oil and remediation of spill impacted sites in a manner that meets international best practice and the oil industry standard. The Contract for Provision of Consultancy Support for Oil Spill and Remediation Services is an integrated approach to the cleanup and remediation of oil spills impacted environment. The objectives of the Contract for Provision of Consultancy Support for Oil Spill/Remediation Services are:

- a. to provide expertise risk investigation of oil spill impacted environment
- b. to provide technical supervisory services to ensure quality of remediation work; and
- c. to ensure that oil spill clean-up and remediation practice meets regulatory requirements

The scope of work for the Provision of Consultancy Support for Oil Spill/Remediation Services will cut across RENAISSANCE's operation areas in East and West Locations.

RENAISSANCE AFRICA ENERGY COMPANY LIMITED hereby announces to interested and prequalified vendors an upcoming tendering opportunity for the provision of Consultancy Support for Oil Spill/Remediation Services activities. The proposed contract will commence Q1 2026, and remain active for 60 months duration, followed by 24 months extension option based on performance within the primary contract period.

### **2.0 SCOPE OF WORK**

The scope of work covers:

1. Execution of Tier 1 and Tier 2 Risk Assessments of crude oil impacted sites in land, Swamp and offshore locations
2. Execution of detailed Soil and Groundwater investigations using appropriate technologies and soft wares.
3. Provision of Remedial Action Plans for Site Remediation.
4. Design of Groundwater Remediation System.
5. Quality Assurance and Quality Control of Remediation Sites.
6. Chemical Testing of Soil, sediments and water samples.
7. Certification of Oil Spill impacted and Remediated Sites with regulators.
8. Provision of Manpower Support for Oil Spill Response and Remediation Activities
9. Provision of Soil and Groundwater Remediation Subject Matter Expert
10. Provision of trainings on Soil and Groundwater Remediation, and Project Management
11. Provision of overall Project Management Services for a portfolio of assigned sites

### **3.0 MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS**

1. To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested contractors are required to be pre-qualified as essential service vendors in the Product Groups – 3.02.02 (Safety, Health and Environmental) Consultancy; and 3.07.08 (Laboratory testing services) Product/Services categories in NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS) data base. Only successfully pre-qualified suppliers in this category will receive Invitation to Technical Tender (ITT).
2. To determine if you are pre-qualified and view product/service category you are listed for, open [www.vendors.nipex-ng.com](http://www.vendors.nipex-ng.com) and access NJQS with your login details, click on continue Joint Qualification Scheme tool, click check my supplier status and then click supplier product group.

3. If you are not listed in a product/service category you are registered with NUPRC to do business, contact NipeX office at 27B Oyinkan Abayomi Drive, Ikoyi, Lagos with your DPR certificate as evidence for necessary update.
4. To initiate the JQS prequalification process, access [www.nipex-ng.com](http://www.nipex-ng.com) to download the application form, make necessary payments and contact NipeX office for further action.
5. NUPRC certification for oil spill response and remediation
6. To be eligible, all contractors must have at least 5 years operating experience in relevant operations in Nigeria, specifically in, Laboratory Services, Technical Consultancy, Onshore Environmental/Waste Management, Design of Soil/Groundwater Remediation Activities and Tier 1 and Tier 2 Assessments.
7. All contractors must have fully active offices with IT support; corporate email address by all personnel; minimum office space of 150msq; with mustering point and dual Entrance/Exit Points.
8. Contractor-owned Laboratories should comply with minimum industry standard for Quality Management Systems - ISO 9001 and ISO 17001.

#### 4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

- a. Demonstrate that entity is a Nigerian registered company with greater than 51% Nigerian Shareholding. Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc.) including company memorandum & article of association and/or evidence of entity's incorporation, shareholding & ownership structure in Nigeria. Tenderer shall provide evidence of registration with the NCDMB NOGIC JQS
- b. Tenderer shall provide evidence of any valid NCEC Category 1,2,3,4 or 5 Consultancy Services (CS) group demonstrating capacity to deploy trained and qualified personnel to execute the work scope.
- c. Tenderer shall (via a letter of undertaking utilizing its letter headed paper) commit to: (failure to provide this undertaking letter will constitute a fatal flaw)
  - Complying with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline to providing Project-specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).
  - In line with the NOGICD Act, deduct 1% NCDF for every subcontract to be issued on the contract and remit same to NCDMB. Tendered shall ensure that the 1% NCDF for all subcontracts must be priced into the commercial submission to be submitted to the Operator.
- d. Provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
- e. Tenderer shall provide documented evidence (not limited to ownership/rental of administrative office, seismic processing facility) demonstrating presence in Nigeria for the execution of the work scope.

#### 5.0 CLOSING DATE

Only Tenderers who are registered in the NJQS product/category 3.02.02 (Safety, Health and Environmental) Consultancy or 3.07.08 (Laboratory testing services) as at the advert closing date shall be invited to submit Technical and Commercial bids after meeting the prequalification requirements.
