1.0 INTRODUCTION

Contract Strategy:

The strategy is to execute framework agreements with technically and commercially successful bidders for the respective services which shall be called out by NNPC E&P Limited based on operational requirements.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work shall involve the provision of personnel, equipment, materials, and services for flowlines/pipelines construction, repairs, and clamping services. Services required will include but not be limited to:

1. Detailed Engineering, Engineering Verification & Engineering pre-job design.
2. Supply of Line pipes, Flowline/Pipeline Construction Materials, Accessories & Consumables
 - i. Line pipes (When not free-issued)

- ii. Flanges
 - iii. Elbows, Bends, etc.
 - iv. Valves, etc.
 - v. Insulation Joints
3. Provision of Equipment, Materials, & Personnel for Flowline/Pipeline Construction, Flowline/Pipeline Repair and Clamping Services
 4. Construction Works: Re-establishment Survey, Right of Way Clearing, Excavation, Backfilling, etc.
 5. Construction Works: Stringing, Beveling, Fit-up and Welding Services for NEPL Land and Swamp Assets
 6. Construction Works: Flowline/Pipeline Laying, Preparation of Cofferdam for Flowline/Pipeline Repairs & Clamping Services for Land & Swamp Assets
 7. Construction Works: Field Wrapping, Provision of Heat Shrink Sleeves, Post Weld Heat Treatment, etc.
 8. Testing & Inspection: Non-Destructive Testing (Visual Inspection, Radiographic, Magnetic Particle Inspection, Liquid Penetrant, etc.) Flushing & Hydrotest, etc.
 9. Provision of Flowline/Pipeline Hook-up & Tie-in, Painting, etc.
 10. Provision of Cathodic Protection Systems (To be treated as a reimbursable)
 11. CASHES (To be treated as a reimbursable)
 12. Project Management (As required NEPL Project Management Team)
 13. Perform the Work according to the HSE Management System in place by NEPL.
 14. Perform the Work according to the requirements of the approved Quality Management System.

3.0 MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

1. To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested Companies are required to be pre-qualified in the relevant categories Product/Services categories in the NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS) database indicated above and must have been live as at advert closing date
All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in the category will receive Invitation to Tender (ITT) document for the Technical & Commercial phase of the tender.

3. If you are not listed in a Product/Service category and you are registered with NUPRC to do business, contact NipeX office at Post Square Towers (Building B), 1, 3 Ologun Agbaje Street Off Adeola Odeku Street, Victoria Island, Lagos, Nigeria with your NUPRC certificate as evidence for verification and necessary update.
4. To initiate the NJQS pre-qualification process, access [<http://www.nipex-ng.com>,/]www.nipex-ng.com, click on the Registration tab, and select "Start NipeX new vendor registration here.
5. To be eligible, all tenderers must comply with the **Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system.**

4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

1. To be eligible to participate in this tender, Tenderers must provide evidence of registration on the NCDMB NOGIC JQS.
2. Demonstrate that entity is a Nigerian registered company with greater than 51% Nigerian shareholding. Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc.) including company memorandum & article of association and/or evidence of entity's incorporation, shareholding & ownership structure in Nigeria.
3. Tenderer shall provide evidence of any of the under-listed NCEC demonstrating capacity and capability to execute the work scope: Category 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 Construction and movable equipment (EC) NCEC demonstrating ownership of construction and Moveable equipment. Category 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 Fabrication and Construction (FC) NCEC for Welding machine, Cranes, Air compressor, piling Hammer, grinding machine etc.
4. Provide evidence of what percentage of your Company's key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.
5. Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development, and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OGTAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s) at tenderer's cost demonstrating presence in Nigeria for the execution of the work scope.
6. The bidders shall comply and execute the contracts in compliance with the Nigerian Oil and Gas Industry Content Development Act 2010 (NOGICD Act) and all applicable laws and regulations especially HCD implementation at bidder's cost.

7. Ensure that all vessels to be engaged in this project or service must be categorized as Nigerian owned in the NCDMB latest Marine vessel categorization or vessel owner must have Category A or B NCDMB Marine Vessel Certificate (NCMVC).

NOTE: Failure to comply with the provision of the Nigerian Content Act 2010 or to demonstrate commitment to the development of the Nigerian Content Policy shall result in the disqualification of the tenderer from the bidding process.

NNPC E&P Limited on behalf of the Joint Venture partners is committed to fully comply with the requirements of the NOGICD Act. In maximizing the local content of this project, pre-qualifiers are requested to give full details of their strategy for the local content implementation to comply fully with the law.

In compliance with NOGICD Act requirements for Research & Development therefore, the following should be noted:

- 1) All Operators or project promoters in the Oil and Gas industry launching service contracts or other applicable projects with completion period of 12 months and above shall provide R&D implementation arrangement with at least one applicable R&D cluster approved by the Board as part of the Operator's Nigerian Content Plan for the project or service. The arrangement shall be in the form of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and indicate how the Operator will deploy the Cluster for any R&D requirements during the contract phase and the first five years of the service life of the field, facility or plant.

All Operators are to include in their ITT documents, a requirement that any service company bidding for such a project shall submit as part of Nigerian Content requirement, a signed MOA between it and one of the R&D Clusters relevant to the project. All service companies are required to sign an MOA with any of the research Clusters. The MOA shall indicate how the service company intends to use the relevant research Clusters during project execution to the satisfaction of the Board. The MOA shall form part of the documents to be reviewed at technical evaluation stage.

5.0 CLOSING DATE

Only Tenderers, who are registered and have **LIVE** status on NipeX NJQS Product/Category Services codes (A, B, C, D and U) as indicated in **Paragraph 1.0** (see table above) as at **16:00 HRS, 15th June 2026**, shall be invited to submit Technical and Commercial Bids.

6.0 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. All costs incurred in preparing and processing NJQS prequalification and responding to this Tender Opportunity shall be to the Contractor's own account.
2. This Advert shall neither be construed as any form of commitment on the part of OPERATOR to award any contract to any Contractor and or associated contractors, sub-contractors or agents, nor shall it entitle Prequalified Contractors to make any claims whatsoever, and/or seek any indemnity from OPERATOR and/or any of its partners by virtue of such Contractors having been pre-qualified in NJQS.
