Contract Strategy:

The strategy is to execute framework agreements with technically and commercially successful bidders for the respective services which shall be called out by NNPC E&P Limited based on operational requirements.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work shall involve the provision of personnel, equipment, materials, and services for Non-Destructive Testing and Inspection Services for Flowline Construction Works on NEPL Operated Land and Swamp Assets.

Services required will include but not be limited to:

All work related to the Non-Destructive Testing & Inspection incidental to the construction and installation of buried Flowlines and Pipelines.

The Contractor shall provide, as minimum appropriate and modern test equipment and tools to carry out tests.

The Contractor shall have capabilities to provide experienced Certification Scheme Welding Inspector (CSWIP) personnel and American Society of Non-Destructive Testing (ASNT) Level III, II personnel as may be required by NEPL on the basis of scope requirement.

All personnel shall possess certification valid for the work.

All NDT related to above ground piping, buried flowlines and pipelines shall be in accordance with the test procedures and acceptance standards indicated in ASME 1X, ASME B31.3, B31.4, B31.8, and API 1104. (for the In-plant piping ASME B31.3 shall supersede)

On the Instruction of NEPL, the following tests will be carried out.

- Visual Inspection
- Radiographic Testing
- Magnetic Particle Inspection
- Liquid Penetrant Testing
- Ultrasonic Testing
- Holiday Detection & Inspection

Contractor shall also cater for the following

- Site works management and supervision of welding processes in accordance with approved procedures
- Quality Assurance/Quality Control
- Project Management

3.0 MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

1. To be eligible for this tender exercise, interested Companies are required to be pre-qualified in the relevant categories Product/Services categories in the NipeX Joint Qualification System (NJQS) database indicated above.

All successfully pre-qualified suppliers in the category will receive Invitation to Tender (ITT) document for the Technical & Commercial phase of the tender.

5. To be eligible, all tenderers must comply with the **Nigerian Content requirements in the NipeX system.**

4.0 NIGERIAN CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

As requested by the Nigerian Oil & Gas Industry Content Development Act 2010, each Contractor will be required to:

1. Tenderer shall demonstrate that the entity is a Nigerian-registered company with 51% or more shareholding capacity. Submit certified true copies of CAC forms 10, 02 & 07 (or its equivalent; CAC 2.3, 2.4, 2.5, etc.). Tenderer shall provide evidence of registration with the NCDMB NOGIC JQS and NUPRC.
2. Tenderer shall provide evidence of what percentage of your key management positions is held by Nigerians and what percentage of the total work force are Nigerians. Also, show

overall percentage of work to be performed in Nigeria and those by Nigerian resources relative to total work volume.

3. Tenderer shall provide detailed description of the location of in-country committed facilities & infrastructure. (Technical/Administrative office, maintenance workshop, etc.) in Nigeria to support this contract.
4. Tenderers shall provide evidence of Category 1, 2, 3, or 4 Quality Control Inspection and Testing (QS) NCEC demonstrating ownership of equipment to execute the work scope.
5. Tenderer shall comply with the latest approved version of NCDMB HCD guideline by committing (via a letter of undertaking) to providing Project-Specific training, man-hour, budget, skill development and understudy plan for Nigerian personnel utilizing OG TAN registered trainer(s) or other approved NCDMB training institution(s).

5.0 CLOSING DATE

Only Tenderers, who are registered and have **LIVE** status on NipeX NJQS Product/Category Services codes (A, B, C, D and U) as indicated in **Paragraph 1.0** (see table above) as at **16:00HRS, 15th June 2026**, being the advert closing date shall be invited to submit Technical and Commercial Bids.

1. All costs incurred in preparing and processing NJQS prequalification and responding to this Tender Opportunity shall be to the Contractor's own account.
